TARPS

To increase our curb appeal and encourage shopping traffic, beginning January 1, 2023, all tarps will need to be consistent. No more different colored tarps, especially blue. What does this mean? Dark grey Tarps of a flame-retardant material will be available for purchase in the Jockey Lot office. These tarps will be purchased in bulk and sold to Vendors at cost. They will include installation

instructions so that all tarps are consistent for improved curb appeal. Please let the office know should you require such a tarp(s).

VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

To avoid additional Fees, please be reminded of the following Rules & Regulations:

- Yellow Lines: Vendors must stay within the yellow lines of their designated booth space. This is for everyone's safety and per fire regulations.
- Speed Limit: Please slow down - The speed limit while on the Jockey Lot premises is always 5mph
- Electric Use: Electricity provided in rental spaces is designed for display lights and light duty fans only. Electric Heaters are prohibited. The Jockey Lot reserves the right to disallow certain items from being plugged into the electricity. (i.e., heaters, air conditioners, cooking devices, multiplug strips) Use of other items will result in a \$35 fee.
- Visual Obstruction: In order to allow shoppers visual access to all our vendors, display racks/partitions must be no more than 3' high for the first 3' of the aisle/front of your booth space.
- Disposal of Property: Merchandise and Vehicles that are unattended, unauthorized and/or abandoned on the property will be disposed of without liability to the Lafayette Jockey Lot. No items (other than display cases/racks) are to be left in a booth at end-of-day Sunday.

RESERVABLE SPACES

RESERVABLE SPACES are intended for the purpose of removing merchandise at the end of day each Sunday. Display racks and cabinets may remain, but all merchandise is to be removed. The purpose of a **LOCKABLE SPACE** is for those Vendors wishing to leave merchandise from week to week. Beginning March 1st this policy will be enforced.

300 RESERVABLE BOOTHS

Please be notified that beginning **January 1, 2023**, rent on all **300 RESERVABLE BOOTH SPACES** will increase to **\$19.00 per day**.
