### TARPS – UPDATE:

**Tarps are expected to arrive by February 14<sup>th</sup>!**

To increase our curb appeal and encourage shopping traffic, beginning **MARCH 1, 2023**, all tarps will be required to be consistent. No more different colored tarps, especially blue.

What does this mean?

1. Heavy Duty, Dark Grey Tarps will be available for purchase in the Jockey Lot office.
2. Please check your booth size as some of you will require a 10' x10' tarp (\$23) while other will need a 10' x 12' tarp (\$24). Both will be available.
3. These tarps will be purchased in bulk and sold to Vendors at cost.
4. Tarps will include installation instructions so that all tarps are consistent for improved curb appeal.
5. Please let the office know should you require such a tarp(s).

### **RENT PAYMENT**

Please be reminded that in order to retain your Booth Space, rent must be received in the office by 3:00 PM Sunday. Those Vendors not paying rent risk losing their booth space. Vendors are always welcome to call with a credit card to secure their booth space for the following week.

### **VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS**

To avoid additional Fees, please be reminded of the following Rules & Regulations:

- Electric Use: Electricity provided in rental spaces is designed for display lights and light duty fans only. Electric Heaters are prohibited. The Jockey Lot reserves the right to disallow certain items from being plugged into the electricity. (i.e., heaters, air conditioners, cooking devices, multiplug strips) Use of other items will result in a \$35 fee.
- Disposal of Property: Merchandise and Vehicles that are unattended, unauthorized and/or abandoned on the property will be disposed of without liability to the Lafayette Jockey Lot. No items (other than display cases/racks) are to be left in a booth at end-of-day Sunday.

### **RESERVABLE SPACES**

**RESERVABLE SPACES** are intended for the purpose of removing merchandise at the end of day each Sunday. Display racks and cabinets may remain, but all merchandise is to be removed. The purpose of a **LOCKABLE SPACE** is for those Vendors wishing to leave merchandise from week to week. The Jockey Lot will begin enforcing this policy beginning in 2023.
