RENT REMINDER:

To secure your booth for the following week your rent is due in the office by 3:00 PM Sunday. If not received, your booth becomes available to online renters at midnight Sunday. Should you call the office to pay your rent, please do so early. Our staff is busy collecting rent at the window and often is unable to answer your call after 1:00 PM.

VENDOR PARKING

Please note that parking at your booth is **not guaranteed**. Parking may not be available at every booth location, and availability will depend on the layout and space at the booth site. If parking is available, **no more than one vehicle per booth is permitted**. Vendors should plan accordingly and be prepared to use designated parking areas if booth parking is unavailable.

MUSIC IN YOUR BOOTH

Vendors are asked to keep any music played in their booth at a **reasonable volume** that does not disturb neighboring booths. While you may enjoy your choice of music, others nearby may not share the same preference or may find it difficult to communicate with customers if the volume is too high. Please be considerate so everyone has a positive experience and can interact comfortably with potential customers.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

BOOTH SPACE

Please be reminded that the yellow floor markings outline the perimeters of your rented booth space. Fire Dept. regulations require you not exceed these dimensions as appropriate aisle space is required for safety purposes. And all merchandise must be taken by end of day Sunday or will be disposed of for a fee of \$25.00
